The International MBE Advisory Committee is proud to present the Al Cho MBE Award at every international MBE conference in honor of Al Cho, “Father of MBE”, and to recognize individuals who have made fundamental contributions to the science and technology of MBE or enabled by MBE. It includes a \$5,000 cash prize and an engraved plaque. The past awardees are Tom Foxon in 2004, Yoshiji Horikoshi in 2006, and Arthur Gossard in 2008. ### **NOMINATIONS**

#### **Rules and Eligibility**

Nominees for the Al Cho MBE Award can come from university, government or companies using MBE technology from anywhere in the world. Individuals must have outstanding credentials, and their pioneering work must have had a significant impact on science and technology of MBE or enabled by MBE.

#### **Administration**

The International Advisory Committee will manage the Al Cho MBE Award. It will be responsible for soliciting and evaluating the nominations and for final selection of the award recipient.
